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**DOCUMENTARY “BLOOD STRIPE: A SPOUSE’S STORY” SET TO MAKE
WORLD PREMIERE IN NOVEMBER**

***New film tells the true story of a story of a family torn apart as a veteran and
his wife struggle with the invisible wounds of war.***

CLEVELAND, OHIO, September 17, 2019 — Hearts of Patriots is pleased to announce that the documentary “Blood Stripe: A Spouse’s Story” will make its world premiere on Nov. 6 at 6:30 p.m. in the Breen Center for Performing Arts in Cleveland.

The film, adapted from Denise Weller's original dance theater production, tells the true story of Megan Cain and her husband, Jeremy, who served in Iraq with the 3/25 Marines. Although Jeremy returned from his tour when many of his fellow Marines did not, he wasn't the same.

Jeremy’s time on the front lines had left him with PTSD and a traumatic brain injury. His mood often swung wildly. He forgot things. Megan didn’t understand what was happening. “As time went on, I seemed to be left with just his anger and resentment,” Megan says in the film.

“Blood Stripe” tells their story of struggle and hope through dance, music and intimate interviews. Hauntingly moving and intensely revealing, “Blood Stripe” is a must-see for military veterans, their spouses and patriotic Americans alike.

A VIP reception kicks off the evening at 5:30 p.m. in the Thomas Room at the Breen Center (1911 W. 30th St., Cleveland). The movie screening begins at 6:30 p.m. and includes live performances by featured artists who appear in the documentary, dancers Juliana Freude and Brian Murphy, and, Nashville recording artist Ricky Lee. A VIP meet-and-greet with the artists, producers, writers and director of the documentary will follow.
